SOCIAL STUDIES: We will be continuing our dinosaur study. We will look at particular dinosaur fossils and become a fossil finder ourselves. We will read more about T-Rex Sue and learn about some different dinosaur bones. Remember to bring your Box-a-saurus Dinosaur tomorrow! This is mandatory this month for the March and final Book It. I can't wait to see your projects!

SCIENCE: Next week we will finish up our planet flip books. We will review chapter 8 Earth and Space with the study guide to go home on Wednesday. The Science test will be on Wednesday, April 11th. Make sure to study over your Easter break.

SPELLING TEST: The spelling words for next week are silent sounds for the vowel sound spelled with –aw -au, -augh, or –al. The words are trickier so please have them read and write these words over the weekend.

MATH: We will be working in Chapter 9 Measurement. We will be doing a quick check on Monday. We will learn pounds and kilograms to measure weight. We will learn cups, pints, quarts, and liters to measure capacity. We will have another quick check on Wednesday. We will also measure temperature. We are doing two pages in math a day usually now because the time allows.

READING: We will be reading *The Signmaker's Assistant*. We will work on silent sounds for the vowel sound spelled with –aw -au, -augh, or –al. We also will learn about word structure, realism and fantasy, contractions, text boxes, and author's purpose.

HANDWRITING: Next week your child will learn the upper case letters N, M, H, and K. Great job on cursive! Keep it up!!
